Here are ways YOU can help us keep our kids safe.

- Encourage proper hand washing at home.
- Remind them to cover their mouth and nose with tissue when they sneeze or cough. If they don't have a tissue, remind them to use their elbow.
- Keep all toys at home except for their Busy Bee rest time snuggle.
- Keep them home if they feel sick, especially if they or someone in your family has symptoms of COVID.
- Regularly pray for our students, teachers, staff and families.
- Be patient and gracious with our administration, teachers and students.

Here are ways WE are working to keep your child safe.

- Teach proper hand washing.
- Teach/remind students about healthy sanitation practices throughout the year.
- Children will be washing their hands throughout their school day.
- All common areas and frequently touched surfaces (door handles, counters, trash containers) will be cleaned throughout the day.
- Preschool restrooms will be cleaned twice a day.
- Toys will be washed and cleaned throughout the day.
- Smaller class sizes to help with social distancing.
- Soft toys will be removed from the classroom.
- Cloth face masks, covering nose and mouth, will be worn by teachers and visitors at all times while in the building except when eating and drinking, or outside and distanced from others.
