### All Day Preschool

8:00 AM – 4:30 PM

Mon. through Fri. = \$810 Per Month

### Morning Class Sessions

8:45 AM – 11:30 AM

2 Days Per Week = \$160 Per Month

3 Days Per Week = \$200 Per Month

4 Days Per Week = \$240 Per Month

5 Days Per Week = \$280 Per Month

### Busy Bee Supplemental Sessions

11:30 AM – 3:00 PM

1 Day Per Week = \$75 Per Month

2 Days Per Week = \$150 Per Month

3 Days Per Week = \$225 Per Month

4 Days Per Week = \$300 Per Month

5 Days Per Week = \$375 Per Month

Busy Bee afternoon sessions include lunch, rest time, extended learning activities, large muscle activities, and a snack.

7:00 AM – 8:45 AM & 3:00 PM – 5:30 PM

Additional care for hours needed outside our classroom schedules. Pay only for what you use. \$4 Per Half Hour.
